

### GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Competition is organised by Glamis Horse Trials. Hereinafter referred to as The Show Organiser within these General Rules and Regulations
2. The Show Organiser reserves the right to decline or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future show or return any entry fee without being required to assign reason or being liable for any compensation.
3. Ponies/horses must be 5 years old and over.
4. **Ponies/horses must have up to date Equine Influenza vaccinations (see BEF guidelines)**
5. The winner of each class is the competitor with the lowest score and in the case of a tie the competitor nearest the optimum time will win.
6. No stop watches or hat cams permitted.
7. Back protectors must be worn. Hats to PAS 015 or EN1384 must be worn and correctly fastened when mounted. No fixed peaks. Suitable footwear must be worn, no trainers or muck boots etc.
8. The Show Organiser reserves the right to split classes, cancel, alter advertised times, limit entries in classes or refuse entry where necessary.
9. All litter must be gathered up and disposed of properly.
10. Please keep dogs on leads at all times.
11. All competitors **MUST** have third party liability insurance or be covered by Pony Club, British Horse Society, British Eventing, or similar, insurance cover.
12. Competitors and spectators must obey officials and stewards.
13. In the case of cancellation, a £10 administration charge, per entry, will be forfeited
14. Entries close on Friday 21st July with a late entry charge of £10 thereafter.

XC: Approx. Height 80cm  
Rider aged 17 or over

Class 5 90: SJ: Max Height 90cm  
XC: Approx. Height 90cm  
Rider aged 16 or under

Class 6 90: SJ: Max Height 90cm  
XC: Approx. Height 90cm  
Rider aged 17 or over

Penalties will be awarded as follows

\*Time allowed is twice the optimum time.

- **It is mandatory for all riders to wear a protective helmet manufactured to PAS 015 with Kite of higher level of protection. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap correctly and securely fastened at all times when mounted.**
- **Body protectors are compulsory.**
- **All competitors MUST have third party liability insurance or be covered by Pony Club, British Horse Society, British Eventing, or similar, insurance cover.**
